Dessert Wine

Lake Hayes Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc

10(g) 60ml **65(b)** 375ml

Central Otago | New Zealand

Intensely aromatic with tropical fruit, pears and marmalade characters typical of ripe Sauvignon Blanc. While it is sweet, the natural acidity balances the sugar to leave a vibrant and refreshing mouthfeel.

Man o' War 'Holystone' Noble Pinot Gris

13(g) 60ml **85(b)** 375ml

Waiheke Island | New Zealand

Holystone Pinot gris is gorgeously perfumed with apricot and citrus notes and is obviously sweet but perfectly balanced with plenty of acidity and age worthiness however it is completely decadent and research has shown that one bottle is never enough. . .

Pegasus Bay Encore Noble Riesling

15(g) 60ml **98(b)** 375ml

North Canterbury | New Zealand

On release, it is a bright lemon-gold colour. The abundant aromas and flavours evoke impressions of ripe cantaloupe melon, mango, pineapple, lychees, and Manuka honey. On the palate, the wine is rich and unctuous. Underneath this, however, there is a streak of minerality and fine acidity that keep it fresh, lively and refined.

Prophet's Rock Vin de Paille

18(g) 60ml **120(b)** 375ml

Central Otago | New Zealand

Hand-picked grapes were dried on racks for 45 days before being pressed and fermented using wild yeasts and kept on the yeast lees for 8 months. Delicious sweet wine with purity and complexity. Quite floral with a backbone of bright acidity. Very impressive.

Man o' War 'Hellburner' Fortified Bordeaux

15(g) 60ml **98(b)** 375ml

Waiheke Island | New Zealand

On the nose there is a huge aromatic lift immediately apparent, with lashings of dark fruit and a very appropriate miasma of shot firecrackers. The palate is vibrant and vivacious with generous sweetness framed by robust tannins and a fresh finish.

Port & Sherry

Turkey Flat Pedro Ximenez

18(g) 60ml

Barossa Valley | Australia

Aged using a Solera system, this blended wine has an average age of 7 years. Careful consideration is given to creating nutty characters with a background of freshness. Lusciously rich and intense with apricot and marmalade characters. Incredibly moreish. This fortified Pedro Ximénez was made from grapes grown in one of the last remaining Pedro plantings in the Barossa Valley.

Lustau East India Solera

14(g) 60ml

Jerez de la Frontera | Spain

Each wine (Oloroso and Pedro Ximénez) is matured, separately in its own solera for 12 years. Once blended together, the resulting sherry is returned to a 45-cask solera for a further 3 years ageing. Dark mahogany in colour with green-amber edge. It offers vibrant notes of maple syrup, brown sugar, shoe polish, and raisin. On the palate it is smooth and rich at the beginning, full of prune and burned oranges peel flavours.

Lustau Pedro Ximenez San Emilio

16(g) 60ml

Jerez de la Frontera | Spain

Pedro Ximenez grapes are laid out in the sun after picking until they are practically raisins. After that fermentation starts slowly and it's halted to maintain all the natural sugars. The resulting wine ages for 12 years in contact with the air in Jerez de la Frontera. The wine is ebony in colour with iodine highlights. The aromas are reminiscent of figs, raisins & dates. Enormously sweet, velvety and soft on the palate, well balanced, with a very long finish.

Ramos Pinto 10yr Port

14(g) 60ml

Douro Valley | Portugal

Reddish tawny to the rim. The rich aroma has a ripe fruit tones with spicy vanilla notes. On the palate, its smooth sweet texture shows mellow ripe fruit with a ripe raisin and spicy wood tone and a bright fresh finish with hints of sweet red fruits and dark chocolate.

Ramos Pinto 20yr Port

18(g) 60ml

Douro Valley | Portugal

This wine has a warm red colour with a slight orange tone at the bottom of the glass. There is a lively aroma with a velvety texture. The aromas include those of fruit, wood, vanilla & cinnamon. Smooth and dry in the mouth, the wine is complemented by a rich and generous persistence of flavour.

Ramos Pinto 2018 Ruby Port

26(g) 60ml

Douro Valley | Portugal

Deep purple, opaque in centre and with a ruby halo. A complex and ripe bouquet dominated by black fruit, blackberries, cherries, plums, cassis wrapped in chocolate and anise. Delicate aromas of violet and bergamot notes. In the mouth is very powerful, dense and with large volume. Silky tannins and well wrapped in all its fruit. Fresh and almost endless finish.

Single Malt Scotch Whisky

Speyside

The most densely populated Whisky region in the world, Speyside whiskies are known for being frugal with peat and full of fruit. Apple, pear, honey, vanilla and spice all have a part a role in expressions from this region, which are commonly matured in Sherry casks.
